

How to report an infringement of copyright

If you believe that a third party marketplace Powered by Marketplacer is being used to host or distribute copyrighted material that you own the copyright for without your permission, first consider whether there is an exception to copyright that applies (such as fair use). If after considering this you would still like to submit a takedown request, you may wish to reach out directly to the marketplace operator using the contact details provided on the website. Alternatively, to submit a takedown request to Marketplacer, please follow the steps outlined below.

Only the copyright owner or their authorized representative may submit a takedown request.

1. Steps to submit a Copyright Takedown Request

Complete the Takedown Request Form.

Send the signed form to takedown@marketplacer.com.

2. What happens next?

If we have questions about your form, we will email you asking for more information and we request that you respond to our email so that we can continue looking into your request.

If your form is complete and valid and the reported content is on a marketplace which is Powered by Marketplacer, we will take action expeditiously including contacting our customer to remove or disable access to the infringing content. Whenever we remove content in response to a takedown request, we provide a copy of the original complaint as well as your contact information to our customer. If our customer does not believe that the content is infringing and/or the content should not be removed, they may reach out to you directly to resolve the issue or they may submit a counter-notice to us.
